

2013 CILLDI Bursary Application Instruction Sheet

CILLDI is pleased to offer two bursary competitions for students at the 2013 Summer School:

- Provost's Award
- Enbridge Indigenous Language Leadership Award

Both Awards use the same application form.

It is important to note that the two Awards have different eligibility requirements. Please read the following information carefully to determine if you are eligible for these Awards.

Eligibility Requirements for the Provost's Award

This Award is open to all 2013 CILLDI Summer School students who register for two 3-credit courses. If you only register for a single 3-credit course, you are not eligible for this Award. There are no restrictions on which courses you can take. This Award is open to both Canadian and International students.

The Provost's Award will cover the following expenses:

- Open Studies application fee
- tuition fees for two 3-credit courses
- on-campus accommodation (including a meal plan) @ St. Joe's dormitory

Note that this Award does not include travel or any other expenses related to attending the Summer School (e.g. parking, library fines, course materials, etc.). Additional partial awards may be made based on availability of funds.

Eligibility Requirements for the Enbridge Indigenous Language Leadership Award

This Award is open to 2013 CILLDI Summer School students who register for two 3-credit courses. If you only enroll for a single 3-credit course, you are not eligible for this Award. Preference will be given to students who hold a Bachelor's degree in Education, and who are working in the area of Indigenous language education. There are no restrictions on which courses you can take. This Award is restricted to students from communities in Treaty Areas 6, 7 and 8.

The Enbridge Award is for \$2,500 and may be applied to tuition, housing, travel or any other costs associated with attending the 2013 CILLDI Summer School.

Please note the deadline for receipt of the application form is 5pm, Monday March 18, 2013.
